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ROUTE DESCRIPTION

Beginning just behind the Pitlochry boating station, this route starts along the footbridge spanning Loch Faskally.

Take in the sights and history of Tummel Bridge, Clunie Arch, Coronation Bridge and picturesque Loch Tummel before reaching Garry Bridge; infamous for its popularity amongst bungee jumpers.

From here, take a short diversion up river to visit the Killiecrankie Visitors Centre and the famous 'Soldier's Leap,' before returning to Pitlochry on signposted National Cycle Network Route 7.
